Hotel Accommodations

Contact the Holiday Inn - Bozeman by **May 15, 2009** at (800) 366-5101 or (406) 587-4561. Be sure to mention you are with the American Highland Cattle Association to receive the rate of \$97/night (1-4 people). If reserving online, go to hibozeman.com and use booking code AHC. The hotel is located at 5 E. Baxter Lane, Bozeman, MT 59715.

Camping Facilities

There are several camping and RV parks in the area; check out visitmt.com. If you stay at a campground you need to provide your own transportation to the Holiday Inn each day for activities.

Travel Arrangements

Gallatin Field Airport is serviced by several major airlines and rental cars are available on site. All details with contact information can be found at bozemanairport.com. Billings Logan International Airport is approximately 150 miles east of Bozeman; check flybillings.com.

There is a complimentary hotel shuttle to/from Gallatin Airport which is just 8 from the Holiday Inn; no reservation is needed. The airport shuttle courtesy phone is located at baggage claim. Upon your arrival to Bozeman, schedule with the hotel front desk to ride it back for your departing flight.

During June, temperatures are typically 50°-70° with rain possible. One third of the annual precipitation falls during May and June. We suggest dressing in layers and traveling with a jacket.

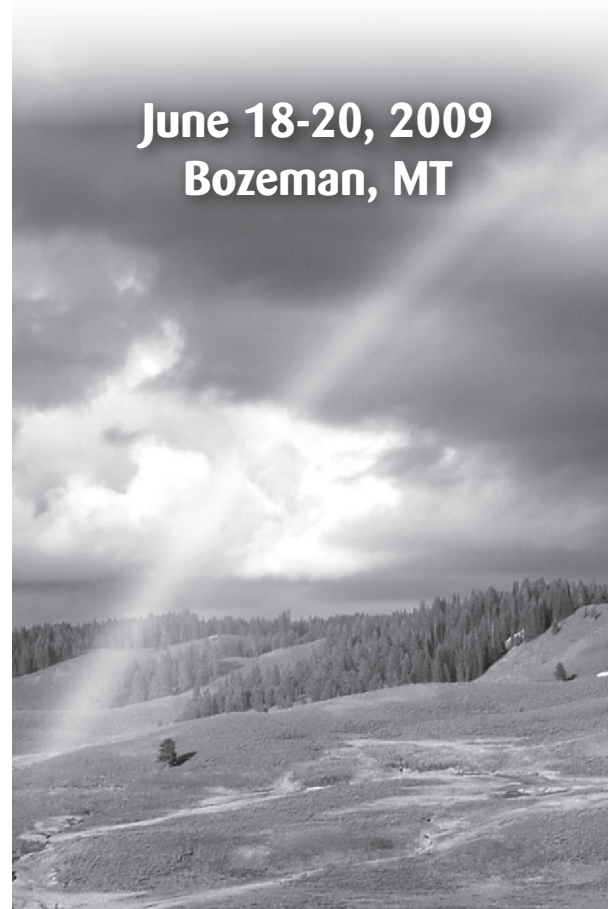
