Entry Rules & Regulations:

Entry Information:

- All NWSS livestock entries are online at <u>nationalwestern.com/livestock-shows/livestock-exhibitors/</u>. All show entries will go to NWSS only.
- Entry fees to NWSS: Entry fees are \$40.00 per head, and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added. Free vehicle parking
 is included with entry. Trailer parking is available for a fee at Dicks Sporting Goods Park. Information can be found at nation-alwestern.com/livestock-shows/livestock-exhibitors/.
- Entry fees to American Highland Cattle Association: \$40.00 and the abbreviated online or paper entry form provided by the AHCA should be submitted to the American Highland Cattle Association as a show fee.
- 4. All Yards and tied cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.
- 5. AHCA registration numbers must be stated on entries.

Special Rules:

- The American Highland Cattle Association offers fifty percent (50%) of the total premiums offered. The National Western Stock Show offers fifty percent (50%) of the premiums offered. Premiums will be paid directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.
- All animals entered must be owned by the exhibitor and registered with the American Highland Cattle Association or the Canadian Highland Cattle Society (CHCS).
- 8. Entries in the following classes are exhibited with the understanding that the owner/exhibitor agrees to abide by the rules set forth in the National Western Stock Show Premium List and the show rules of AHCA.
- 9. Registration papers or current photocopies thereof must be presented to the show officials or AHCA representatives upon request. Tattoos must be legible and correspond to registration papers or the animals will not be allowed to show.
- 10. Health inspection certificates must be turned in upon arrival to the veterinarian's office on the "Hill". Each sale animal must have an individual health certificate. Three (3) copies of each certificate are required. Show animals only may be listed together on one (1) health certificate but three (3) copies of this certificate are required.
- 11. Classes with less than three (3) animals may be combined with other classes.
- 12. Exhibitors must post an 8 1/2" x 11" card over each animal in the stall area stating: animal's name, registration number, birth date, sire and dam.
- 13. With the exception of animals in the National Sale, no "for sale" signs will be posted.
- 14. No dehorned animals, except market cattle and Sovereign heifers, will be allowed to show.
- 15. All bulls 12 months or older must be shown with a nose ring or nose lead or will be excluded from exhibition at the discretion of Stock Show and in the interest of safety to spectators.
- 16. National Western Stock Show awards ribbons through 5th place.

Highland Groups:

Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder points will be awarded based on the five(5) highest placing animals in the individual classes (no points for divisions, grand champions, group classes or unregistered steers): 1st-5, 2nd-4, 3rd-3, 4th-2, 5th-1

Highland Jackpot Group:

IMPORTANT - All group classes must be pre-entered. No entries can be accepted after the deadline.

- 1. 1. The show begins after the Junior Show. This show is a jackpot format. All premiums paid by AHCA directly.
- 2. 2. All fullblood breeding animals must have been entered in individual classes. All animals must be owned by same owner.
- 501 Best Pair of Heifers
- 502 Best Pair of Bulls
- 503 Best Three Head three (3) animals limit one (1) bull per entry

Sovereign Heifer and Market Show Rules:

- Cattle must be raised and handled in a humane manner. No added hormones, anabolic steroids or subtherapeutic feed antibiotics can be applied/fed.
- 2. All entries must comply with NWSS Livestock Health Requirements.
- 3. Market cattle must be minimum weight of 900 lbs. on show day. Finishing during the final 100 days should be such that each animal gains at least 1.5 lbs. per day.
- 4. Market cattle must be maximum of 30 months old.
- 5. Feeder animals must be maximum weight of 899 lbs. on show day.
- 6. Fullblood market animals must be from a registered Highland sire and dam. Crossbred animals must be from a registered sire or dam. Registered Sovereign heifers must be polled, scurred or dehorned. Market cattle may be horned or dehorned.
- 7. Sovereign heifers must be registered with AHCA.
- 8. Market cattle may be registered with AHCA, however it is not required. Only registered animals count towards Premier Breeder and Exhibitor. Unregistered market cattle must be tattooed with the original owner's herd letters. This tattoo along with sire and dam registration names and numbers must be noted on the entry form.
- 9. The market show may be divided into more than one class (by weight) depending on number of entries. The feeder and prospect classes may be divided into more than one class (by age) depending on number of entries.
