A minimum of one \$1500 scholarship will be awarded and can be used towards any post-secondary institution expenses (university, college, trade or technical schools). Payment will be made to the institution but mailed to the recipient.

The only requirements are that your application be completed in full, is postmarked no later than **May 10, 2025** (return to the address below) and you are an AHCA junior member who is currently in your senior year of high school or who is currently attending a post-secondary institution and not over 21 years of age. If you have not yet graduated, entered post-secondary education, etc. these questions should be answered with your tentative plans in mind. You may only be awarded the scholarship once.
